All library Code of Conduct rules apply, as well as any directions given by library staff. Participants who do not follow directions or who behave inappropriately will be asked to leave. Tweens participate at their own risk. The library cannot be responsible for participants' health or fitness.

By signing below, my tween and I acknowledge that:

- We have read the below Overview of Library Code of Conduct and agree that tweens will abide by all rules listed therein, as well as those presented by library staff during library events
- We understand that, if a tween's behavior is unacceptable, they will be asked to leave an event; the emergency contact listed above will be contacted and asked to pick up their tween from the library
- We understand that, once admitted to a library event, tweens will not be permitted to leave until the end of the event unless behavior is unacceptable or a grown-up guardian releases them early
- Tweens who are not picked up within 15 minutes of the end of a library event will be left in the custody of police until a family member or guardian comes to pick them up
- The library is not liable for any risks taken or injuries incurred by participating in library events

Overview of Library Code of Conduct

Please...

- Be respectful of others, including other library users and staff.
- Please be safe and courteous, wear a shirt and shoes, and follow library policies.
- Be respectful of library property and the property of others.
- Personal items are welcome in the library and are the responsibility of the owner of those items.
- Service animals are permitted inside the building and must be under control at all times. Please do not tether animals outside of the building or leave animals unattended.
- Smoking and vaping are not allowed within 50 feet of library property.
- The use of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited on library property.

Remember, if it is prohibited by law, it is also prohibited in the library and/or on library grounds.
